

COMMUNITY DOCK USE POLICY

Currently (2018) Owners may use a dock slip at the Crystal Bay Pavilion Dock area on a first come first served basis. Dock slips to the left side of the main pier/walkway are considered for seasonal usage, while the dock spaces at the end of pier/walkway are considered day use slips. Boats on the right side of the pier/walkway (ramp side) are for short term use for boaters loading and un-loading from their trailers. The loading area is gated with a swing-style bar/gate and secured with a lock and boaters are asked to secure the gate when loading is completed each visit. Boat Ramp and Storage Unit lock codes are provided to all owners. You may contact the Grounds and Maintenance personnel for guidelines if needed or contact the Crystal Bay Secretary email: crystalbay2@gmail.com if you need help.

NOTE: There was a rock addition to the end of the concrete ramp in 2017. Rock is now overlapping the end of the concrete approximately 2 feet to minimize the erosion under the concrete. The rock extends approximately 12 feet past the end of the concrete ramp in a fan configuration, tamped in by a Bob-Cat.

Owners are required to follow the Decal Policy for their boats, trailers and towing vehicles. Decals are available thru the Crystal Bay Secretary. Requests can be made thru email: crystalbay2@gmail.com
